Denturists work with you to ensure that your new dentures feel good, look good and perform well, while you are living life to the fullest.

Fit

- Do your dentures fit?
- Do your dentures feel loose?
- Do your gums hurt?
- Your Denturist will help you find the solution for the best fit possible: relines, precision dentures or implant-retained dentures may be the answer for you.

Form

- How do your dentures look?
- Do they reflect the natural, attractive smile you want?
- Do you like the way your teeth look?
- Let your Denturist work with you to find the right look and feel. Professional cleaning, repairs or new precision or implant-retained dentures can give you the appearance you've been looking for.

Did you know?

You don't need a referral to visit a Denturist. Denturists must be licensed with the College of Denturists of Ontario in order to practise in Ontario, and their Certificate of Registration must be prominently displayed in their office.

Function

- How well do your dentures work?

- Do you avoid certain foods?
- Does it hurt to chew?
