Re-taking the Qualifying Examination

If you are applying to take the Qualifying Examination after either withdrawing or having been unsuccessful at an attempt of the Qualifying Examination, a completed Qualifying Examination Registration Form and the applicable fee are required. However you are not required to provide photographs, official transcripts, or proof of identification from Step 1.

If you are registering for a re-attempt of the examination, please ensure to include your CDO Candidate ID number.

Special Needs Accommodation

If you have a temporary or permanent physical impairment, or any persistent cognitive, psychological, sensory or learning impairment which substantially limits your participation in one or both components of the Qualifying Examination, you may make a request for special needs accommodation.
