**ORDER**

**THIS HEARING** was held on Thursday, August 30<sup>th</sup> in Toronto, Ontario.

**ON READING** the Notice of Hearing, the Agreed Statement of Facts and the Joint Submission on Penalty, and on hearing the submissions of counsel for the College of Denturists of Ontario (“College”) and counsel for Mr. Polishchuk:

**1. THE DISCIPLINE COMMITTEE FINDS** Mr. Polishchuk guilty of professional misconduct pursuant to paragraphs 2 (failing to maintain the standards of practice of the profession) and 32 (contacting or communicating, directly or indirectly, with a person in an attempt to solicit patients) of section 1 of the Ontario Regulation 854/93 – Professional Misconduct, a regulation under the *Denturism Act, 1991*, S.O. 1991, c. 25.

**2. THE DISCIPLINE COMMITTEE ORDERS** Mr. Polishchuk to appear before a panel of the Discipline Committee to be reprimanded, the fact of which shall be recorded on the register; and,

**3. THE DISCIPLINE COMMITTEE DIRECTS** the Registrar to impose a specified term, condition and limitation on the certificate of registration of Mr. Polishchuk that he successfully complete, at the his own expense, a course on ethics, with an advertising component if available, such course to be approved in advance by the Registrar. Mr. Polishchuk must provide to the Registrar proof of successful completion of the course in a form acceptable to the Registrar by no later than November 1, 2012.

**4. THE DISCIPLINE COMMITTEE FURTHER DIRECTS** the Registrar to publicize this matter in the usual manner through, among other things, the College's publications, which publication will include, among other things, the member's name.
