**O R D E R**

**THIS HEARING** in writing was heard this day and on December 15, 1997, by the  
Discipline Committee.

1. **THE DISCIPLINE COMMITTEE FINDS** William Kenyon guilty of professional  
misconduct as set out at paragraphs 45 (failing to pay a fee or amount owed to the College)  
and 47 (unprofessional conduct) of section 1 of Ontario Regulation 854/93 made under the  
*Denturism Act*.

2. **THE DISCIPLINE COMMITTEE ORDERS** that William Kenyon's certificate of registration be suspended for a period of three months commencing August 1, 1998, until and including October 31, 1998;
  
3. **THE DISCIPLINE COMMITTEE ORDERS** that a condition be imposed on William Kenyon's certificate of registration that he construct ten new sets of dentures on a pro-bono basis for persons otherwise unable to afford them. William Kenyon shall provide proof to the College that he has completed the dentures by no later than December 31, 1998. If William Kenyon fails to complete the dentures as required, his certificate of registration will be suspended for a further period of three months from January 1, 1999, until and including March 31, 1999;
  
4. **THE DISCIPLINE COMMITTEE ORDERS** that William Kenyon pay costs to the College of \$5,000;
  
5. **THE DISCIPLINE COMMITTEE ORDERS** that William Kenyon be reprimanded;
  
6. **THE DISCIPLINE COMMITTEE ORDERS** that a condition be imposed on William Kenyon's certificate of registration that his certificate of registration will not be reinstated following the suspension until he has done the following:
  - a) paid the College's costs as referred to in paragraph 4 above;
  - b) brought his fees up-to-date; and

c) has provided proof to the College that he has professional liability insurance.
